Training on Use of Language Lab

A training session on “Use of Language Lab” was organized for the students and teachers on 27th of April, 2022 by the Department of English in collaboration with Orell Technosystems (India) Pvt. Ltd., Kolkata in online mode to enable the participants to use audio-visual equipments to help students learn a foreign language. Dr. Kishor kr. Deka, the head of the Department of English addressed the students and faculty members and spoke on the need to use the language lab for improving English speaking skills. The resource person was Mr. Sayad Biswas, a technical expert from Orell Techno Systems. He emphasized that the training on language laboratory is designed to help students develop their listening, speaking, reading, and writing skills in the target language. He explained that the language laboratory is a facility that consists of a number of individual booths, each equipped with a computer, headphones, and a microphone. Students can listen to recorded materials, practice speaking the language, and receive feedback from the teacher. Language laboratory training is an effective way to learn a foreign language. The lab provides a personalized learning environment where students can work at their own pace and receive individual feedback from the teacher. It also allows students to practice their listening, speaking, reading, and writing skills in a safe and supportive environment.

The training covered a variety of topics, including:

Pronunciation : Students learn how to pronounce the sounds of the target language correctly.

Grammar : Students learn the basic grammar rules of the target language.

Vocabulary : Students learn new words and phrases in the target language.

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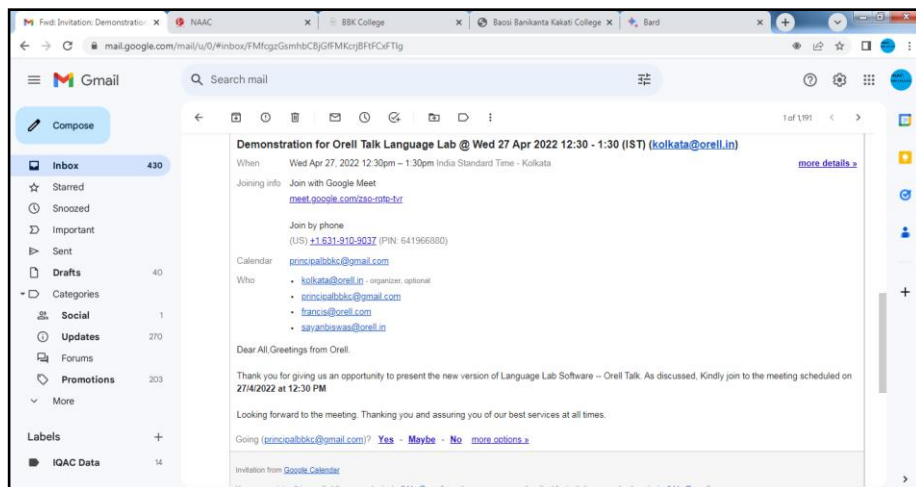
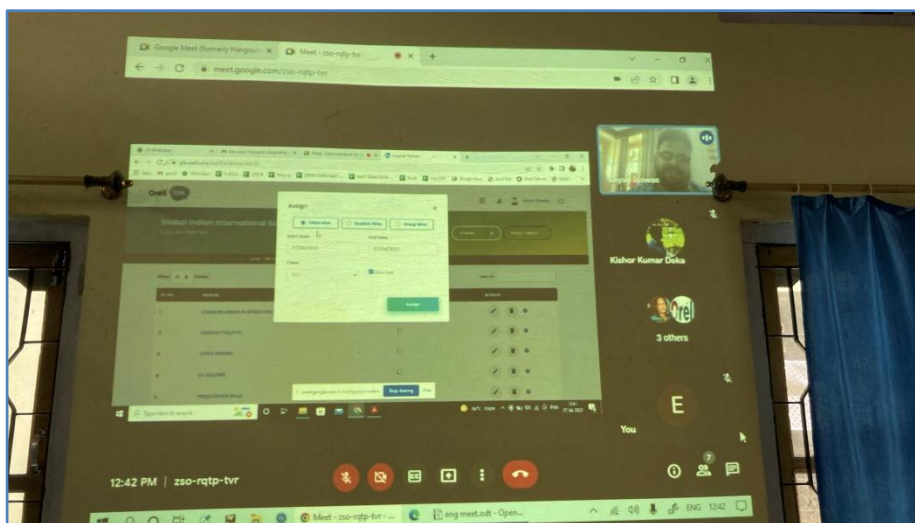


Fig.3: Snapshots of Online Presentation




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
