Colonial/ Imperial World**”

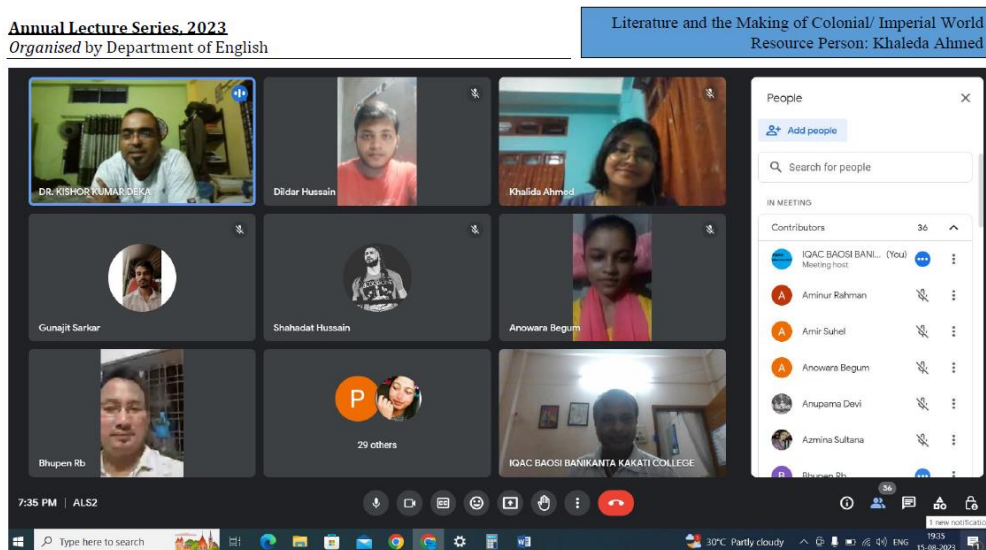
