Report on-Dr. Banikanta Kakati Memorial Lecture

Today, the 22nd of November, 2023 "Dr. Banikanta Kakati Memorial Lecture" was organized in New Hall by the Department of Assamese in collaboration with IQAC of the college in honour of Dr. Banikanta Kakati, a prominent linguist, literary figure, critic and scholar in Assamese language.

The resource person on the occasion was Dr. Anuradha Sarma, Professor, Department of Assamese, Gauhati University.

The programme started with lighting of lamps and paying of floral tributes at the busts of Dr. Banikanta Kakati and Mahendra Mohan Choudhury.

The lecture session started with a brief introductory note on the occasion by Bhabajit Bayan, the head of the department of Assamese.
