Baosi Banikanta Kakati College - A Profile

Baosi Banikanta Kakati College was established at Nagaon of greater Baosi locality on 25th July, 1971. This college came into existence as a result of the indefatigable effort of Late Mahendra Mohan Choudhury, a noted freedom fighter, former Chief Minister of Assam and former Governor of Punjab. Baosi was once a seat of diverse cultural and religious activities of Vaishnavite Preacher Mahapurush Srimanta Shankardeva and his disciple Mahapurush Madhabdeva along with Damodardev and Haridev. Then in the late 19th century, Baosi was endowed with a worthy son of Assam, Dr. Banikanta Kakati. Dr. Kakati was a great scholar, linguist, literary critic and academician of great repute. Thus, the name of the college Baosi Banikanta is conflation of 'Baosi' and 'Banikanta Kakati'.

Baosi Banikanta Kakati College is ideally nestled amidst the lush green paddy fields and sylvan serenity, 12 kilometres away from the din and bustle of the urban atmosphere of Barpeta town. "Gurukulashram". As this is essentially a rural college, the academic needs of the local populace is given utmost importance. Since the inception, the college has been able to keep intact the attraction of the youths as a preferred destination of higher education in lower Assam. In this way the college, having the special focus on relevant present day educational drives along with the emphasis on all round development of the students has successfully completed the 48th year of academic excellence.

- a) Higher Secondary courses in Arts and Science.
- b) Three Year Degree Courses (consists of six semesters) in Arts and Science.
- c) Three Year Degree Course (six semesters) in Computer Application (BCA)
- d) One year Post Graduate Diploma (two semesters) in Computer Application (PGDCA)

2. Subjects offered in Higher Secondary Course :

Arts : Eligibility : H.S.L.C. or equivalent recognized examination.

Science : Eligibility : H.S.L.C. or equivalent recognized examination.

Subjects : English, MIL (Assamese and Hindi), Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Biology, Anthropology, Economics

Combination of subjects in H.S. Course :

A. Arts:

- (i) English is compulsory.
- (ii) A student must select one Modern Indian Language, either Assamese or Hindi.
- (iii) A student must select three/ four elective subjects from the following list:
 - (a) Economics (b) Political Science (c) Logic & Philosophy (d) Education
 - (e) Anthropology (History/ Mathematics/ Adv. Assamese/ Arabic

3. Subjects offered in Degree courses :

For Honours & Regular Courses

Arts : Anthropology, Assamese, English, Economics, Education, Political Science, Hindi, History, Mathematics, Arabic, Philosophy.

Science : Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Zoology, Botany

Duration of all B.A/BSc/BCA Degree Courses

The duration of the courses shall be of three years consisting of six semesters.

SELF FINANCED COURSES :

1. BCA Eligibility: Minimum requirement for admission to the course is H.S. or equivalent examination in any stream. Student not from Science stream will have to take up a Bridge course in addition to the normal course in the 1st semester.

2. Post Graduate Diploma Course in Computer Application (PGDCA)

Course Duration : The duration of the course is one year consisting of two Semesters.

Eligibility: A student with a Bachelor Degree of 10+ 2+ 3 pattern in any discipline is eligible for the course, preferably students having Mathematics at the Higher Secondary level and obtaining minimum pass mark in the subject is eligible for admission. Candidates not having Mathematics at the Higher Secondary level will have to pursue a Bridge course.

3. Courses under Distance mode

The college is going to introduce various courses under Krishna Kanta Handique State Open University (KKHSOU) for the session 2020-21.

COLLEGE FEES STRUCTURE

For HS (Arts & Science) & Degree (Arts & Science) Courses, as per Govt. guidelines.
BCA & PGDCA Courses will be self financed

COLLEGE UNIFORM

College uniform is compulsory for all students.

For boys : Pink coloured shirt and ash coloured trousers

For girls : Pink coloured Kurta and white salwar (trousers) with white dupatta or pink coloured blouse and white mekhela chadar with pink border.

COLLEGE IDENTITY CARD

New Identity cards are issued to the fresh students. Old Identity Cards are to be surrendered at the end of each academic session. For renewal of Identity Card an additional amount will be charged. Students are advised to keep the college identity card with them during college hours.

ADMISSION AND ATTENDANCE**ADMISSION PROCEDURE**

- ❖ Application for admission into the college will be through online mode.
- ❖ Please follow the detailed instructions for uploading relevant documents while applying for admission specified in the admission web page.
- ❖ Admission into the college is strictly made on merit basis and is governed by the college admission rules. The Principal's decision is final in this regard.
- ❖ Reservation of seats is as per Govt. rule.
- ❖ A few seats are reserved for students having extra-curricular activities in the field of sports, culture and NCC.
- ❖ HS and Degree students who have failed may also apply for admission along with the fresh applicants. However no extra preference will be given to them.

ADMISSION OF UNSUCCESSFUL STUDENTS

The procedure of admission of unsuccessful students is governed by the rules of Gauhati University and Assam Higher Secondary Education Council.

ATTENDANCE RULE

- ❖ Students having less than 75% class attendance will not be allowed to fill up forms of HS 1st year and Final examination.
- ❖ Degree students must have 75% of class attendance in order to fill up forms of Final examination of Gauhati University.
- ❖ For allotting Internal Assessment marks in Degree examination, at least 75% attendance of the total number of classes held is necessary.
- ❖ Regular attendance in classes will give extra weightage to the internal marks.

Procedure for Internal Evaluation : As per G.U. guidelines.
CREDIT & GRADING : As per G.U. guidelines. The guidelines are available in every department.

GENERAL RULES FOR MAINTENANCE OF DISCIPLINE

- ❖ The students admitted to the college must abide by all the rules and regulations as prescribed by the college authority. Violations of the rules, unsatisfactory progress, irregular attendance, irregular clearance of college fees, showing discourtesy to the teachers and staff members in any form, adoption of unfair means during examination etc. are some of the offences which will lead to disciplinary action.
- ❖ Every student must carry their 'Identity Card' inside the campus. It must be produced for verification when demanded by the authority.
- ❖ Every student must wear the college uniform inside the college campus.
- ❖ Prior permission of the authority is necessary to represent the college at outside forums.
- ❖ Use of cellular phone is strictly prohibited inside the classroom during class & examination hours.
- ❖ Students should keep college campus clean. Spitting, smoking, disfiguring the walls etc. are strictly prohibited. Any student found guilty of doing so shall be subject to expulsion from the college.
- ❖ All forms of ragging inside the college campus is strictly prohibited.
- ❖ Consumption of gutkha, sikhar and other alcoholic or narcotic drugs in the college campus is strictly prohibited.
- ❖ All powers of maintenance of discipline are vested with the Principal. In all cases, the decision of the Principal shall be final and binding.

EXAMINATION RULES AND EVALUATION PROCESS

Examination Rules (General)

The authority strictly adheres to the College Examination and Promotion rules. There will be a unit test examination for HS 1st and 2nd year students and in addition, a test examination for HS 2nd year students. There will be a sessional examination for the degree courses on the dates prescribed in the prospectus of the college. Based on this, students will be allowed to fill up the forms of final examinations held by AHSEC / Gauhati University. Students unable to appear in a test on medical grounds must submit application along with medical certificates prior to the test. Under no circumstances, medical certificates will be entertained in more than one test.

Examination Rules and Evaluation of TDC under Semester System

- ❑ In case of any dispute regarding evaluation or unforeseen events, the matter may be placed in the Committee of Courses and Studies (U.G.) for amicable settlement. Since the semesters involve continuous assessment, there shall be no scope for a student to appear as a system, the existing University Rules and the Gauhati University Act 1949 (as amended till date) shall be applicable.
- ❑ The rules of examination and evaluation of degree students are as per the examination and evaluation rules of Gauhati University, which is available at the official website of Gauhati University and B.B.K. College.
- ❑ All Final Examinations will be held as per AHSEC and Gauhati University routine.

REGARDING ANTI-RAGGING

As per the UGC Guideline [No. F 1-16/2007 (CPP-II), April, 2009], all forms of ragging in hostels and the college campus are prohibited. Clause 3.4 of the above mentioned regulation defines “Ragging” as :

Any conduct whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness any other student, indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities which cause or likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in a fresher or a junior student or asking the students to do any act or perform something which such student will not in the ordinary course and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of a fresher or a junior student.

Ragging is considered as a cognizable offence under the law of the land and ragging in all its forms is totally banned in the entire institution, including its departments, constituent units, all its premises (academic, residential, sports, canteen etc.) whether located within the campus or outside and in all means of transportation of students whether public or private.

Punishable ingredients of Ragging are (1) Abetment of ragging (2) Criminal conspiracy to rag (3) Unlawful assembly and rioting while ragging (4) Public nuisance created during ragging (5) Violation of decency and morals through ragging (6) Injury to body, causing hurt or grievous hurt; (7) Wrongful restraint (8) Wrongful confinement (9) Use of criminal force (10) Assault as well as sexual offences or unnatural offences (11) Extortion (12) Criminal trespass (13) Offences against property (14) Criminal intimidation (15) Physical or psychological humiliation (16) All other offences following from the definition of ‘Ragging’ (17) Attempts to commit any or all of the above mentioned offences against the victim(s).

The College Authority has set up an empowered ‘Anti-Ragging Committee’. Under mentioned disciplinary actions may be taken if any student is found to be involved directly or indirectly in ragging:

1. Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges
2. Withholding / withdrawing scholarship/ fellowship and other benefits
3. Debarring from appearing in any test/ examination or other evaluation process
4. Withholding of results.
5. Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival etc.
6. Suspension/expulsion from the hostel.
7. Cancellation of admission.
8. Rustication from the institution for period ranging from 1 to 2 years.
9. Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specified period.
10. Fine ranging between 25,000/- and 1,00,000/-.
11. Collective punishment : When the persons committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identified the authority will resort to collective punishment.

In the event of any complaint regarding ragging no one can plead ignorance to be excused from punitive action.

STUDENT SUPPORT SERVICES

HOSTEL FACILITY

The College has hostel facilities for both boys and girls. The seats are allotted strictly on merit basis. Some seats are reserved for the remote area commuters and SC / ST / OBC students. To avail hostel facility, students will have to apply separately to the principal.

Hostel Fees (for both Boys & Girls) : As per govt. guidelines.

CANTEEN

The college has a canteen to supply food in reasonable price during working hours.

XEROX FACILITY

Xerox facility is available in the college. Every student can avail this facility by paying Rs. 1/- (Rupees one) per copy.

EXCURSION

Educational tours are organized by various departments. The college also organizes excursion annually. To promote awareness of global and comprehensive understanding of educational scenario, Special Educational Tours are organized by the college. This will be undertaken during the autumn recess.

The students for these tours will be selected strictly on merit and medical fitness. The number of students for the excursion will be limited to 24, of which two will be ex-officio members of the Students' Union.

Educational Tour During Autumn Recess : Educational tour will be arranged separately by respective departments and hostel during autumn recess.

Every regular student of the college is a member of the College Students' Union. The Students' Union co-ordinates the participation of the students in co-curricular activities. The Students' Union publishes BBKCIAN'- the college magazine annually to promote literary and creative activity among students.

NSS

To promote work-culture activity among students and for their growth towards becoming good citizen, there is a branch of NSS (National Service Scheme) in the college. Students are expected to avail this facility by enrolling their names in this branch.

NCC

In addition, a unit of NCC (National Cadet Corps) has been introduced from 2008 with a vision to promote character building and to create team spirit, sense of sacrifice and dedication. Students will be able to feel the pride of nationalism through this unit.

BHARAT SCOUTS & GUIDES

The college introduced Bharat Scouts and Guides unit from the year 2017 which is registered under the Bharat Scouts and Guides of Assam unit.

Issue of Books : 11.00 am to 3.00 pm

Central Library has three well-accommodated and well-furnished separate reading rooms for students and teachers with audio-visual facility. It has a collection of about 22,000 textual and reference books. The library subscribes to 10 national and regional monthly/fortnightly journals and 8 dailies. UGC INFLIBNET-NLIST e-journal has been subscribed by the central library for the benefit of faculty members and students as well. The Library has the open access system. There is also book bank facility for meritorious poor students.

LIBRARY RULES :

A student may borrow two books at a time and keep the books for a maximum period of 15 days from the date of issue. If he/she does not return the books within 15 days, a fine of 50 paise per day up to the next 15 days and Rs 1/- per day there after will be imposed.

Internet service is available in the central library of the college.

DEPARTMENTAL LIBRARY :

Each department has rich collection of textual and reference books on the subject concerned. Students may borrow books from the departmental library subject to the procedure and rules of the department concerned.

Moreover, both the boys and women's hostels have separate library facilities.
